RED CROSS CPR/AED – ADULT with STANDARD FIRST AID 2011

Designed to train lay responders to overcome any reluctance to act in emergency situations and to recognize and care for life-threatening respiratory or cardiac emergencies in adults. It will provide the lay responder with the knowledge and skills necessary in an emergency to help sustain life and to minimize pain and the consequences of injury and sudden illness until professional help arrives. Here you will learn how to give CPR, respond to breathing emergencies, and how to use an automatic external defibrillator (AED).

All participants will have face shields for breathing techniques, as Red Cross still includes this skill in their teaching Skills Checklist for Certification.
